2. Promote the game of petanque in the ACT and the broader community.	2.1 Increase awareness of petanque activities through online media, participation in community programs and events and regular social play. 2.2 Provide opportunities for skills development of players, umpires and others.
3. Enhance the social benefits of participating in petanque as an organised social sport.	3.1 Provide members with access to a wide social and competitive network of petanque players and clubs across Australia through the Petanque Australia. 3.2 Organise social activities with club members and members of the public.
4. Sound governance.	4.1 To ensure the Club has the processes and systems in place to meet the financial and organisational obligations specified under its Constitution.
